Public Hearing Minutes Community Development Block Grant (CDBG) Application May 4, 2021

The Terrell County Board of Commissioners held a public hearing on May 4, 2021 at 10:30 AM at the Terrell County Board of Commissioners' office. In attendance were County Administrator - Ms. Davina Driver, Grant Writer - Ms. Barbara Reddick from Southwest Georgia Regional Commission (RC), County Clerk, Sandra O'Stean, County Commissioner Staff Member - Mechelle Miller and no citizens were present for the hearing.

County Administrator called the meeting to order at 10:38 AM and Ms. Barbara Reddick explained the purpose of the hearing is to obtain residents view on the City's request to submit a CDBG application to the state to obtain funding for sewer system improvements in a targeted area. In addition, Ms. Reddick explained the CDBG program's local match requirements, program eligibility requirements and eligible CDBG program grant amounts. Ms. Reddick explained the CDBG's rating factors to determine scoring for each application. In more details, Ms. Reddick discussed the door-to-doors survey documentation that is needed to determine the low-to-moderate income count of the target area, Still Waters Engineering was selection as engineering firm for this project. Also, the Language Access Plan requirements were discussed and a copy of the LAP data map from DCA's website was reviewed that show 0.00% of the citizen speaks Spanish which does not trigger the threshold to translated vital documents for the County. Ms. Reddick concluded stating the grant application submission date is June 4, 2021.
